1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Assam Petrochemicals Limited (APL) was set up to utilize the huge reserve of Natural Gas in the Upper Assam oil fields and also to meet the requirement of increasing national demand for Methanol and Formalin. Incorporated in 1971, the company was a pioneer in the field as it was the first to manufacture petrochemicals in India using natural gas as feedstock. Its Petrochemical plant was set up in Namrup, Dibrugarh Dist. of Assam.

Assam Petro-Chemicals Ltd. is now implementing a mega project of 500 TPD Methanol and 200 TPD Formaldehyde plant as an expansion project of the company at a total cost of Rs. 1709 crores. The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi virtually dedicated the 500 TPD Methanol Plant of the Company in service to the Nation on 14.04.2023. Besides the project work of 200 TPD Formalin Plant in Boitamari of Bongaigaon district is well in progress. Government of Assam, Oil India Limited and Assam Gas Company Limited are investing in equity capital for implementation of 500 TPD Methanol and 200 TPD Formalin project. Government of Assam along with Assam Gas Co. Ltd and AIDC Ltd. will hold 51% of shares and Oil India Ltd. will hold 49% of the equity capital of the company.

1.2. The site for the New Plant:

The new 500 TPD Methanol Plant is set up in the land area adjacent to existing location of APL factory at Namrup.

1.3. Approach to site:

The APL factory is situated at Namrup in the district of Dibrugarh, Assam, India. Namrup is connected with Dibrugarh by national Highway NH-37 and is at a distance of around 70 KM from Dibrugarh and around 65 KM from Dibrugarh Air Port. The nearest railway Station is Namrup Station and is at a distance of 9 KM. The Station has siding facilities suitable for handling Project equipments. The Railway Track is Broad Gauge.

1.4. The Plot area has an existing Natural ground level of 124.4 m from the MSL.

2. BIDDER'S QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

a) TECHNICAL:

1. Bidders shall have experience in last seven years of having successfully carried out and completed similar work as specified in 1.2.2 during calculated from the month previous to the one in which applications are invited, which experience should be any one of the following:

Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 10,94,689.00 of the estimated cost.

1.2.2 Work order and completion certificate must include all the followings.

- a. Scope of work is to supply, packing, forwarding, loading, un-loading at site, storage, preservation, inspection at vendor's works, installation, testing & commissioning of electrical equipment / systems.
- b. - d. Laying of 1000V grade, Aluminium conductor XLPE insulated Armoured Cable (Make: Polycab/ KEI) of 3.5 Core X 300 Sq. mm XLPE Insulated, Armoured LT Alluminium Conductor.
- e. The Contractor's scope of work shall cover furnishing all materials, handling of material, equipment, plant, labour, transport, approach roads, tools and all other services necessary for the complete execution of works, including all surveying and setting out necessary for the works including transfer of levels from existing available bench mark and clean up of working areas after completion of the works. All statutory labour laws must be complied.
- f. The works are to be carried out at the location as directed by the Engineer-in-charge. The bidder may visit the site to get acquainted with the existing site condition and to assess the amount of work before submission of the Priced Bid. Any extra claim on account of any variation from the details furnished in this tender document will not be entertained. Contractor shall understand the complete scope of work as stipulated in the Bid Document.
- g. The work shall consist of construction of all the civil foundation required for installation of Transformer, Breaker panel, change-over panel etc. as per the GA drawing of the equipment, this also include dismantling of existing brick work, PCC floor & fencing and reconstruction of PCC floor, drain as per specification and dimensions.
- h. Any activity not specifically mentioned in the tender but necessary in the opinion of engineer in charge of work must be carried out for successful completion of the job.
- i. Some restrictions may be imposed by the Department for movement of vehicles, materials, labours and contractor bound to follow all such restrictions/Instructions and nothing extra shall be payable on this account or due to less/reduced working hour etc
- j. Royalties at the prevalent rates shall have to be paid by the contractor.
- k. Any working space required for storing of construction materials, equipment, tools and tackles shall be arranged by Contractor, at his own cost and time. All the materials, tools and tackles required for successful completion and installation of the works shall be in the scope of Contractor.
- I. Contractor has to ensure that sufficient water is available at site for proper execution of work at his own cost.

- m. The bidders shall note that no deviations from the technical specifications or commercial conditions with this bid are acceptable & it will be presumed that the bidder agrees entirely with the specifications & general terms & conditions of the contract.
- n. Unless otherwise specified in the schedule of quantities, the rate of all items of work shall be considered as inclusive of pumping out or bailing out of water from all depth if required for which no extra payment shall be made. This will include: encountered from any source, such as rain, flood, high sub-soil water table,: seepage whatsoever etc.
- o. Contractor may store all construction materials, equipment, tools and tackles at site at his own risk and cost. All the materials, tools and tackles required for successful completion and installation of the works shall be in the scope of Contractor.
- p. All panel Drawings & Transformer must validated by Engineer-in Charge.
- q. Insulation mats must be provided in front of the panel.
- r. Danger sign as relevant standard must be provided for all Panels and transformers.
- s. Earth-pits must with be Numbered with Earth pit value and date
- t. The Contractor is required to strictly follow all the rules and regulations of Government of India and State of Assam and all local rules and bye-laws, etc.
- Bidder shall provide necessary barricading while carrying out the construction works if required.
- v. The labour colony shall be provided by the Contractor outside the plot premises at his own cost.
- w. All works shall be carried out in accordance with the technical specifications of this document and as directed by Engineer in charge
- x. Construction power and Construction water shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost. If Contractor has to set up a DG (Diesel Generator); it has to be as per the Local Statutory Norms.
- y. Price shall be submitted for all items and the quoted price shall be firm. The price shall include all materials, handling of material, plants, machineries and equipment, labour, tools, & services, royalty, transport, supervision, but exclusive of GST.
- z. There is no free issue material to the contractor.

- aa. Contractor shall ensure local participation to the extent possible for execution of works.
- bb. Owner reserves the right to split the contract; however the rates/ prices shall remain valid.
- cc. Handing over the site to the complete satisfaction of the Engineer in charge/Owner.
- dd. bidders shall note that no deviations from the technical specifications or commercial conditions with this bid are acceptable & it will be presumed that the bidder agrees entirely with the specifications & general terms & conditions of the contract.
- ee. During the execution of the work if it is found that the work is not progressing as per the Scheduled Progress Program, approved by the Corporation & planned by the Contractor, due to the reasons attributable to the Contractor; suitable action shall be taken as per relevant clauses mentioned in General Conditions of Contract
- ff. The notice inviting tender, general instructions to the contractors & all documents of this tender shall form part of the contract.
- gg. The Contractor shall take all requisite & necessary care to observe that no damage is occurred to the Existing structures, if any. For any damage to the Existing Structures of APL, the Contractor shall be held responsible.

4. BIDDERS WHO CAN BID

- **4.1.** Parties who are affiliates of one another can decide which affiliate will make a bid. Only one affiliate may submit a bid. Two or more affiliates are not permitted to make separate bids directly or indirectly. If 2 or more affiliates submit a bid, then any one or all of them are liable for disqualification. However up to 3 affiliates may make a joint bid as a consortium, and in which case the conditions applicable to the consortium, and in which case the conditions applicable to a consortium shall apply to them.
- **4.2.** "Affiliate" of a party shall mean any company or legal entity which:
 - a) Controls either directly or indirectly a party, or
 - b) Which is controlled directly or indirectly by a party, or
 - c) Is directly or indirectly controlled by a company, legal entity or partnership which directly or indirectly controls a party. "Control" means actual control or ownership of at least a 50% voting or other controlling interest that gives the power to direct, or cause the direction of, the management and material business decisions of the controlled entity.

4.3. Bid may be submitted by:

- a) A single person/ entity(called sole bidder)
- b) A newly formed incorporated joint venture(JV) which has not completed 3 financial years from the date of commencement of business.
- c) A consortium(including an unincorporated JV) having a maximum of 3(three) members;
- d) An Indian arm of a foreign company.

- 4.4 Fulfilment of pre-qualification Criteria and certain additional conditions in respect of each of above 4 types of bidders stated below, respectively:
 - a) The sole Bidder (including an incorporated JV which has completed 3 financial years after date of commencement of business) shall fulfil each pre-qualification criterion.
 - b) In case the bidder is a newly formed and incorporated joint venture and which has not completed three financial years from the date of commencement of business, the neither the said JV shall fulfil each eligibility criteria or any one constituent member/promoter of such a JV shall fulfil each eligibility criteria. If the bid is received with the proposal that one constituent member/promoter fulfils each eligibility criteria, then this member/promoter shall be clearly identified and he/it shall assume all obligations under the contract and provide such comfort letter/guarantees as may be required by owner. The guarantees shall cover inter alia the commitment of the member/promoter to complete the entire work in all respects and in a timely fashion, being bound by all the obligations under the contract, an undertaking to provide all necessary technical and financial support to the JV to ensure completion of the contract when awarded, and undertaking not to withdraw from the JV till completion of the work, etc.
 - c) In case the bidder(s) is/are a consortium (including an unincorporated JV), then the following conditions shall apply:
 - i. Each member in a consortium may only be a legal entity and not an individual person;
 - ii. The bid shall specifically identify and describe each member of the consortium;
 - iii. The consortium member descriptions shall indicate what type of legal entity the member is and its jurisdiction of incorporation (or of establishment as a legal entity other than as a corporation) and provide evidence by a copy of the articles of incorporation (or equivalent documents);
 - iv. One participant member of the consortium shall be identified as the "prime member" and contracting entity for the consortium; this prime member shall be solely responsible for all aspects of the bid/proposal including the execution of all tasks and performance of all consortium obligations;
 - v. The prime member shall fulfil each eligibility criteria;
 - vi. A commitment shall be given from each of the consortium members in the form of a letter signed by a duly authorized officer clearly identifying the role of the member in the bid and the member's commitment to perform all relevant tasks and obligations in support of the prime/lead member of the consortium and a commitment not to withdraw from the consortium till completion of all ENQUIRY obligations;
 - vii. No change shall be permitted in the number, nature or share holding pattern of the consortium members after pre-qualification, without the prior written permission of the owner.
 - viii. No change in project plans, time tables or pricing will be permitted as a consequence of any withdrawal or failure to perform by a consortium member;
 - ix. No consortium member shall hold less than 25% stake in a consortium;

- x. Entities which are affiliates of one another are allowed to bid either as a sole bidder or as a consortium only;
- xi. Any person or entity can bid either singly or as a member or only one consortium.
- d) In case the bidder is an Indian arm (subsidiary, authorized agent, branch office or affiliate) of a foreign bidder, then the foreign bidder shall have to fulfil each eligibility criteria. If such foreign company desires that the contract be entered into with the Indian arm, then a proper back to back continuing (parent company) guarantee shall be provided by the foreign company clearly stating than in case of any failure of any supply or performance of equipment, machinery, material or plant or completion of the work in all respects and as per the warranties/guarantees that may have been given, then the foreign company shall assume all obligations under the contract. Towards this purpose, it shall provide such comfort letter/guarantees as may be required by owner. The guarantees shall cover inter alia the commitment of the foreign company to complete the entire work in all respects and in a timely fashion, being bound by all obligations under the contract, an undertaking to provide all necessary technical and financial support to the Indian arm or to render the same themselves so as to ensure completion of the contract when awarded, an undertaking not to withdraw from the contract till completion of the works, etc.

5. BIDDER'S PROPOSAL:

- a. To enable thorough and fast scrutiny of the BIDDER's proposal, BIDDER's are advised to respond all their technical data in the enquiry by clearly marking out their response, wherever they want to provide additional data and / or they deviate from the specified requirements. In case of full compliance, the enquiry specification and data sheets will remain unaltered.
- b. The BIDDER is advised to furnish all information called for in summary of data to be furnished along with the bid & after acceptance of Purchase order
- c. BIDDER shall carefully study all sections of this specification, drawings and indicate all deviations in the schedule of deviations only. It will be presumed that the offer conforms in all other respects to the specification and the PURCHASER reserves the right to evaluate the bid, as such without any further reference to the BIDDER. It is binding on the BIDDER to supply the equipment and system in conformity with the specification except for the deviations stated in the schedule of deviations and accepted by the PURCHASER.
- d. BIDDER could provide additional data on their proposal by compiling the same under schedule F without altering the specification structure.
- e. BIDDER is advised to quote for the complete scope and partial response will not be entertained. In case of few items which do not directly fall under BIDDER's manufacturing range and / or not available from indigenous source, BIDDER should take the responsibility upon them to arrange to procure those items and supply to ensure that their proposal is complete in all respects.

f. Ignorance of the site shall not be accepted as basis for any claim for compensation. The submission of the tender by the BIDDER will be construed as evidence that such an examination was made and any later claims / disputes in regard to price quoted shall not be entertained or considered.

6. CONTRACTOR SHALL COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- a. Within 10 days of receipt of Letter of Intent (LOI) the Contractor shall submit a detailed methodology for carrying out all works as per the scope of the tender, details of main equipments, procurement specifications for all materials to be procured which shall be approved by the Engineer in charge before placement of order. These submittals shall be consistent with the general information submitted by the Contractor with his Tender and with modifications, if any, subsequently agreed to by the Engineer-in-Charge and the Contractor.
- b. The Contractor shall take into account the peak demand on materials according to the approved construction schedule.
- c. Contractor shall ensure that latest versions of all relevant IS codes in hard: copies are available at Site office for ready reference.
- d. Contractor shall ensure that all necessary construction tolerances shall be adhere during construction as specified in the drawing/Technical specifications or as per relevant IS standards and/or as directed by the Engineer in charge.
- e. Contractor shall submit necessary material consumption calculations to achieve the desired quality as per relevant IS codes which shall be approved by engineer in charge before commencement of work.
- f. Bidders shall be deemed to be fully conversant with the Specifications including Technical specifications, drawings, general conditions, instructions to bidders, etc and all terms and conditions of the Invitation to Bid. The Bid shall be prepared and submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements of this bid document. No deviations with Specifications, general conditions, etc, are allowed.

7. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

I. The BIDDER shall possess valid electrical BIDDER's license of appropriate Class from the concerned statutory authorities governing the area of work place. Electrical Supervisor License in Form – B with name of the supervisor endorsed in the Electrical License by the Competent Authority. The validity for both the document must be up dated The BIDDER shall comply with the relevant statutory rules and regulations. In addition to this all the supervisors / electricians employed to carry out the erection at site shall hold the statutory certificates of competency for the nature of work entrusted and shall fully meet the requirements of the local electrical inspectorate prior to commencement of the work.

- II. All site test reports in a specified format maintained by the VENDOR, duly approved by CONSULTANT/OWNER shall be handed over to the APL after completion of job.
- III. All hardware i.e. screws, bolts, fastener, for all equipments shall be of G. I.Cadmium plated.
- IV. Bidder shall arrange through Engineer-in-charge for the coordination of his works with those of other trades and shall arrange his works to avoid interference with or interruption to the general construction program.
- V. The BIDDER will be required to carry out the erection side-by-side with other erection being executed by the other BIDDERs. The BIDDER shall extend all co operation as may be required to other BIDDER in carrying out their work.
- VI. BIDDER shall work round the clock if site requirement calls for without any additional cost without compromising quality and safety. In this case BIDDER shall meet all the requirement of statutory bodies, local legal bodies and safety rules of OWNER.
- VII. During the progress of work, Engineer-in-charge will have the power to order verbally or in writing from time to time, the dismantling / removal and proper re execution of any work in respect of workmanship, if the same in his opinion is not in accordance with the specifications, standard engineering practice or the existing rules and regulations as given in the contract. The electrical BIDDER shall carry out such orders at own cost.
- VIII. Bidder shall keep the site of work in a clean and sanitary condition. All scrap material generated while working shall be collected from site and shall be deposited to OWNER Scrapyard /dustbins from time to time. All the packing material used for various electrical equipments like, cable drums, thermo cols, carbouys, wooden pallets etc shall be deposited at OWNER Scrapyard. Acid Carbouys shall be washed before deposition to the store.
- IX. Bidder shall be responsible for regular cleaning and maintenance of all electrical equipments till the commissioned equipment is finally accepted by OWNER.
- X. In case the cleaning is not to the OWNER satisfaction, he will have the right to carry out the cleaning operations and any expenditure incurred by the OWNER in this regard will be to the BIDDER's account.
- XI. All site test reports in a specified format maintained by the BIDDER, duly approved by the site Electrical incharge shall be handed over to the OWNER after completion of job.
- XII. After the completion of entire work, the BIDDER should arrange to remove all the temporary structures, surplus materials, dirt, debris, etc. from the site and finished work shall be handed over to the Owner in a clean and complete state.

- XIII. The BIDDER is required to submit the list of sub-vendors for the equipment he is supplying. This list will be subject to the approval of OWNER
- XIV. In case panel is manufactured by Sub-vendor, the vendor must be sent to CPRI approved & ISO certified electrical panel manufacturer.

8. INSPECTION OF EQUIPMENT:

- 2) If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a criminal offence under the IPC / PC Act, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform its Vigilance Office and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

Section 2 - Commitments of the Bidder / Bidder

- (1) The Bidder / Bidder commit itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.

 - d) The Bidder / Bidder will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- (2) The Bidder / Bidder will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

Section 3 - Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts

If the Bidder, before award of contract has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 or in any other form such as to put his reliability or credibility as Bidder into question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidder from the tender process or to terminate the contract, if already signed, for such reason.

- (1) If the Bidder / Bidder have committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 such as to put his reliability or credibility into question, the Principal is entitled also to exclude the Bidder / Bidder from future contract award processes. The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of the transgression. The severity will be determined by the circumstances of the case, in particular the number of transgressions, the position of the transgressors within the company hierarchy of the Bidder and the amount of the damage. The exclusion will be imposed for a minimum of 6 months and maximum of 3 years.
- (2) The Bidder accepts and undertakes to respect and uphold the Principal's absolute right to resort to and impose such exclusion
 - (3) Apart from the above, the Principal may take action for banning of business dealings / holiday listing of the Bidder as deemed fit by the Principal.

- (4) If the Bidder / Bidder can prove that he has restored / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal may revoke the exclusion prematurely.
- (5) A transgression is considered to have occurred if in light of available evidence no reasonable doubt is possible.

Section 4 - Compensation for Damages

- 1) Without prejudice to any rights that may be available to the Principal under law or the Contract or its established policies and laid down procedures, the Principal / Owner shall have the following rights in case of breach of this Integrity Pact by the Bidder/ Bidders): Forfeiture of EMD / Security Deposit: If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated the Contract or has accrued the right to terminate the Contract according to Section 3, the Principal apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal, may in its considered opinion forfeit the Earnest Money Deposit / Bid-Security amount of the Bidder / Bidder.
- (2) If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to Section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Bidder liquidated damages equivalent to 5% of the contract value or the amount equivalent to Security Deposit / Performance Bank Guarantee, whichever is higher.
- (3) The bidder agrees and undertakes to pay the said amounts without protest or demur subject only to condition that if the Bidder / Bidder can prove and establish that the exclusion of the Bidder from the tender process or the termination of the contract after the contract award has caused no damage or less damage than the amount of the liquidated damages, the Bidder / Bidder shall compensate the Principal only to the extent of the damage in the amount proved.

Section 5 - Previous Transgression

- (1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 3 years with any other Company in any country conforming to or with any other Public Section Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.
- (2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or the contract, if already awarded, can" be terminated for such reason.
- (3) If the Bidder / Bidder can prove that he has resorted / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal may, at its own discretion as per laid down organizational procedures, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Section 6 - Equal treatment of all Bidders / Bidders / Sub-Bidders

(1) The Bidder / Bidder undertake to demand from all sub bidders a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder / Bidder shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement / Pact by any of its Sub bidders / Sub-vendors.

- (1) The Principal appoints competent and credible external independent Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.
 - (2) The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently.
 - (3) The Bidder accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all Project documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Bidder. The Bidder will also grant the Monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his project documentation. The same is applicable to Sub-bidders. The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder / Bidder / Sub-contractor with confidentiality.
 - (4) In case of tenders having an estimated value of Rs.100 Crore, the Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the Project provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Bidder.
 - (5) As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- (6) The Monitor will submit a written report to the CEO of the Principal within 2 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the 'Principal' and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.

- (7) If the Monitor has reported to the CEO of the Principal substantiated suspicion of an offence under the IPC / PC Act and the CEO has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Vigilance Office, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India,
- (8) The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

Section 9 - Pact Duration

This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Bidder / Bidder 12 months after the completion of work under Contract or till the continuation of guarantee period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the contract is awarded.

If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified it is discharged / determined by the CEO of the Principal.

Section 10 - Other Provisions

- 1) This agreement is subject to Indian as well as state of Assam local laws. Place of performance and jurisdiction is the Registered Office of the Principal, i.e. Guwahati.
- 2) Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 3) If the Bidder is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 4) Should one or several provision of this agreement turn out to be invalid the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.


